Dominic's mother was a victim of violence. She wanted to look after her child but was unable to because of financial constraints. Dominic was placed in a very loving and caring foster family where he quickly made himself at home. However, he was still missing his mother and felt anxious when he couldn't meet with her. Our social workers arranged meetings with his grandparents who expressed interest to start looking after him. Dominic was eventually reintegrated with them as he could not settle in the foster family.

Foster care is really something amazing

"I have been in a foster family for two years now" – tells the girl while wiping her tears. "Before I went there, I lived with my biological mother, but she could not take care of me, so I went with my grandmother and uncle. Unfortunately, they left for Australia and had to go to an institutional home. For the five days I spent there, I realized how uncomfortable the whole environment was- from the auntie who looked after the children to the children themselves. I was very lucky because in one of the five days I was there, a social worker came by to tell me that a family wants to take me. I can not describe how happy I was. Foster care is really something amazing"
